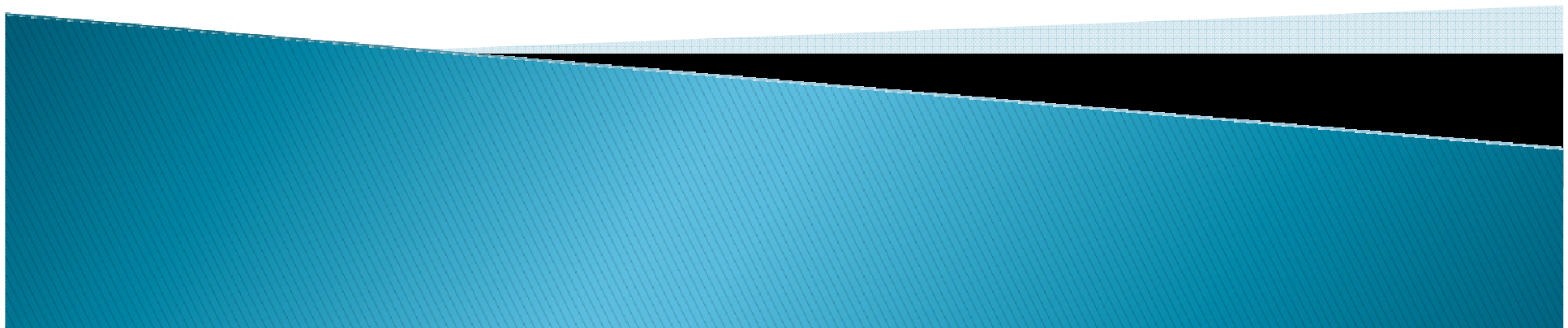
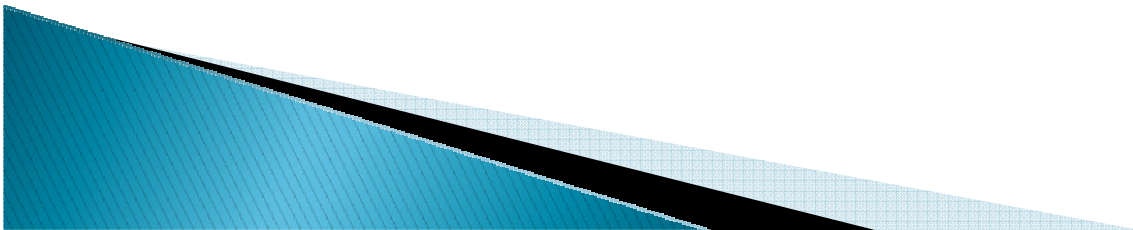


Our WAVE presentation

- We were getting complaints about our spud supreme orders in our school...

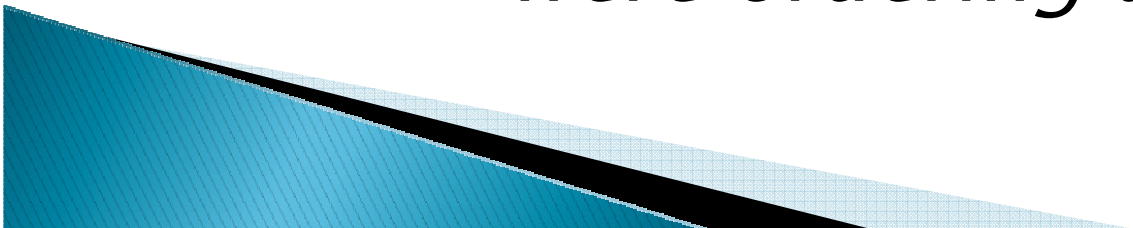


We took a survey to find out what the problems with SPUD SUPREME were.

 - They were cold

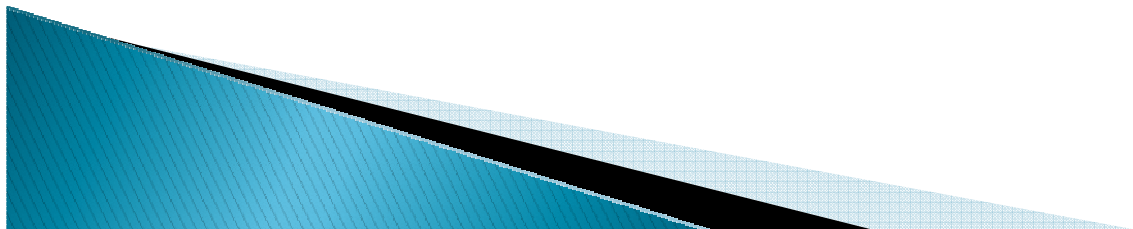
And at the time it was not worth having SPUD SUPREME because only 3-6 people were ordering a week
